During this time Jill also volunteered to develop a stretch/movement program for patients and staff at the Lombardi Cancer Center.

Jill has been recognized for her volunteer work over the years. In 2009 she was the recipient of the "President's Call to Service Award" under President Obama and has volunteered at her children's school as the Secretary, Vice President, and President of the Corpus Christ School PSA Board. Jill also remains an advisor for Arts For All, Inc. in New York City.

Mr. Alden said, "Jill will continue to lead the DEA Educational Foundation to new heights. She is creative and passionate about 'making a difference'."

Ms. Roberts resides in Southern California with her husband, a documentary filmmaker, and her two children.
